Practice and Weigh-Ins

The course will be available for practice at the following times (subject to change):

- **Wednesday, April 13, 2022: 12:00 PM – 6:00 PM**
- **Thursday, April 14, 2022: 8:00 AM – 6:00 PM**
- **Friday, April 15, 2022: 8:00 AM – 10:30 AM (and after the last race has been completed, if time allows)**
 - Practice is not allowed outside of these times
 - Launching ends 30 minutes prior to the end of practice

Weigh-Ins will take place in the breezeway and are scheduled for the following times (please refer to the regatta packet for specific weigh-in procedures):

- **Thursday, April 14, 2022: 4:00 PM – 7:00 PM (coxswains official weigh-in only and rowers test weigh-in)**
- **Friday, April 15, 2022: 6:00 AM – 11:00 AM (coxswains and rowers official weigh-ins)**
 - Coxswains only need to weigh-in once during either scheduled time

Regatta Time

- **Regatta Time = US Naval Observatory**
 - <https://www.usno.navy.mil/USNO/time/display-clocks/simpletime>
- **The regatta is always on time!**
 - Recommended launch time is 45 minutes before your event
 - In the unlikely event that we fall behind, the starter will get us back on schedule. **NEVER** assume it is safe to launch late!

- **Traffic patterns are posted on Regatta Central and the SIRA website, as well as physically posted at the docks**

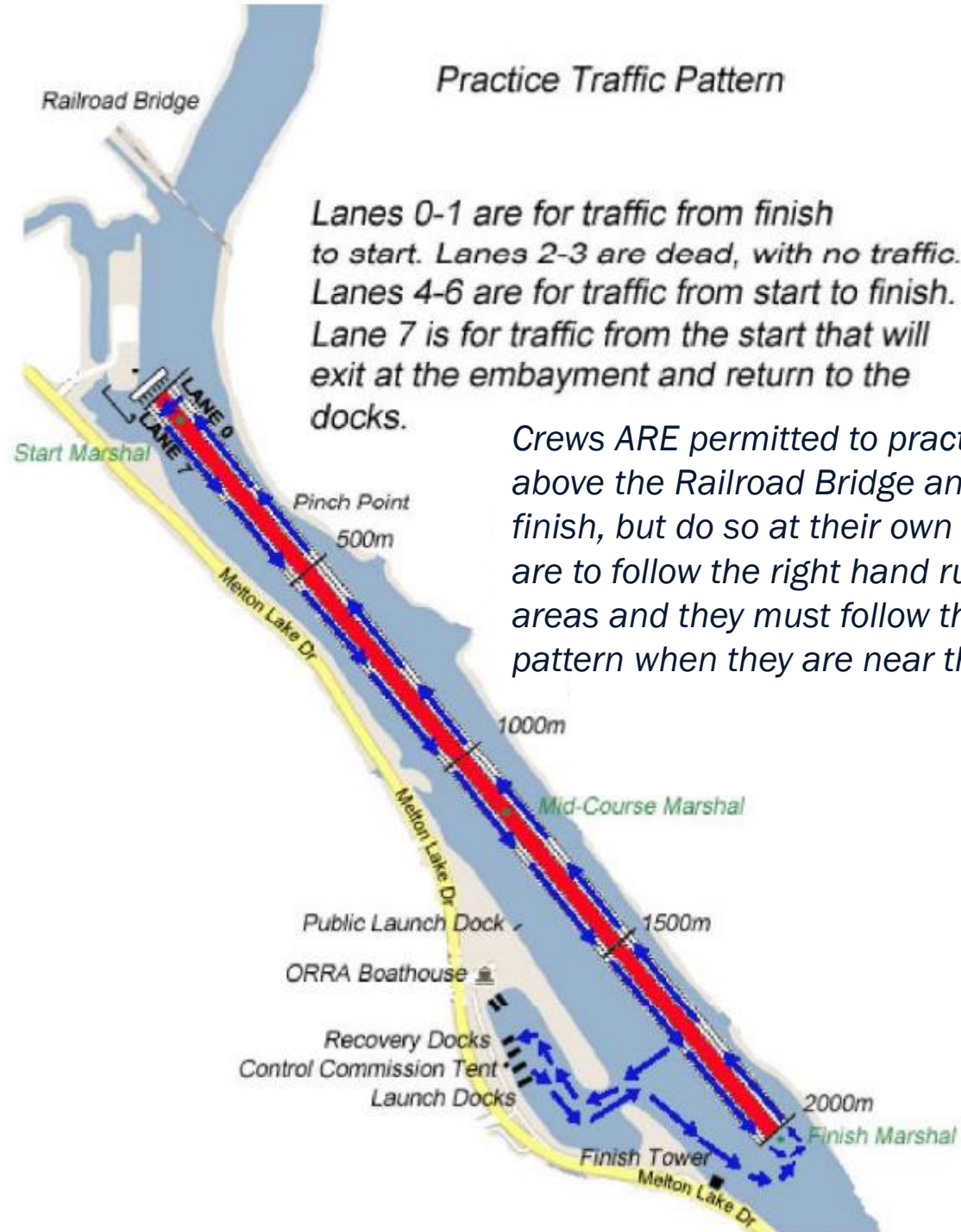

TIME TRIALS TRAFFIC PATTERN

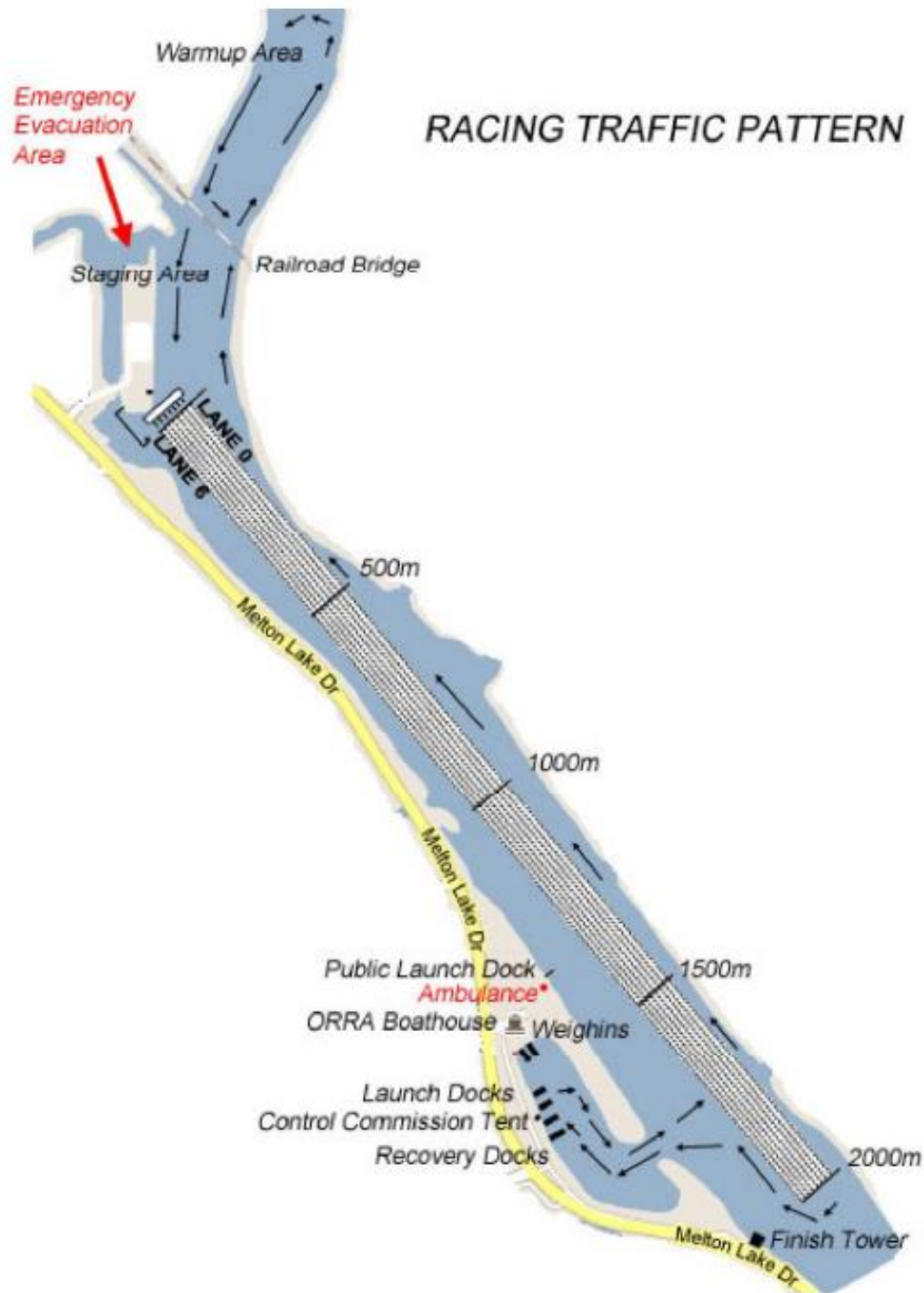

USRowing Rules of Rowing

- It is your responsibility to know and understand the Rules of Rowing
- Equipment:
 - You have signed that your equipment meets the rules (3" heel ties, bowball is firmly affixed, etc.)
 - Referees will perform visual checks each time you launch
 - Bow numbers are critical! Crews must provide their own bow numbers (except for time trials)
 - If you lose your bow number, or your bow (lane) number is incorrect, inform a Marshal ASAP
- Broken equipment:
 - Alert the nearest Referee and we will do everything we can to let you race

Rules and Information of Note

- **Bow Numbers**
 - Each crew is to supply its own bow number (except for time trials)
- **Safety Checks**
 - Safety checks shall be done visually
 - If a Race Official has concerns about the safety of equipment, they shall have the competitor demonstrate that the equipment meets the requirements in the Rules of Racing
- **Docks**
 - The number of people on the launch and recovery docks at any given time will be limited to no more than necessary to ensure safe launching and landing
 - The members of the Control Commission will manage the adherence to this rule (everyone must comply with their instructions)

On the Water – Notes and Warm-Up

- If a Referee gives you an instruction, please acknowledge with a hand so we know that you have heard us
- In proximity of the course:
 - Do not stop on the start line or where you will drift into the Aligners line of sight
 - Do not sit at the finish line as a race is finishing
- Warm-Up
 - Follow the Traffic Pattern and know what it is each day
 - Stop your warm-up along the race course as a race is approaching or passing

On the Water – Sprint Starts

- The Starter will call you onto the course after the race in front of you clears the breakage area (do not enter the course until you are invited)
- Minimize how much backing you need to do (do not travel too far down your lane before attempting to lock onto the stakeboat)
- The Starter will give time to race updates roughly every minute
- You must be locked on 2 minutes prior to your race or you may receive a warning for being late to start
- The Starter may start the race at any time within the 2-minute window
- Hands will not be recognized during the Start:
 - Crews will be polled in a steady cadence – You will hear the “Attention” command and after a pause you will hear GO!
 - If the Starter is interrupted, crews will hear “As you were” and the Starter may choose to re-poll the crews or perform a quick start
- If you leave the start, you accept the start, you cannot protest the start at the finish!
- The Breakage Zone is 100 meters

On the Water – Racing and Finish

- **Sprint - Racing**
 - Chase Official(s) will follow behind all races and will use white flags to correct any course deviations that impact your safety or the fairness of the race
- **Sprint - Finish**
 - Hear a horn
 - See the orange flag drop (from the finish)
 - Objections must be initiated on the water
 - If there is a question of fairness or another issue, please raise your hand at the finish and talk to the referee
 - Please have in mind:
 - What happened to you
 - What impact it had on you
 - What resolution you are seeking
 - After your conversation, if your issue has not been resolved, let the referee know if you plan to submit a protest
 - Protests must be filed, along with a \$50 fee, within one hour of your boat returning to the recovery docks

Unsportsmanlike Conduct

Among other things, profanity is not considered “sportsmanlike,” even when used to motivate; profanity may never be directed at another crew or regatta personnel. Unsportsmanlike conduct is grounds for exclusion or disqualification.



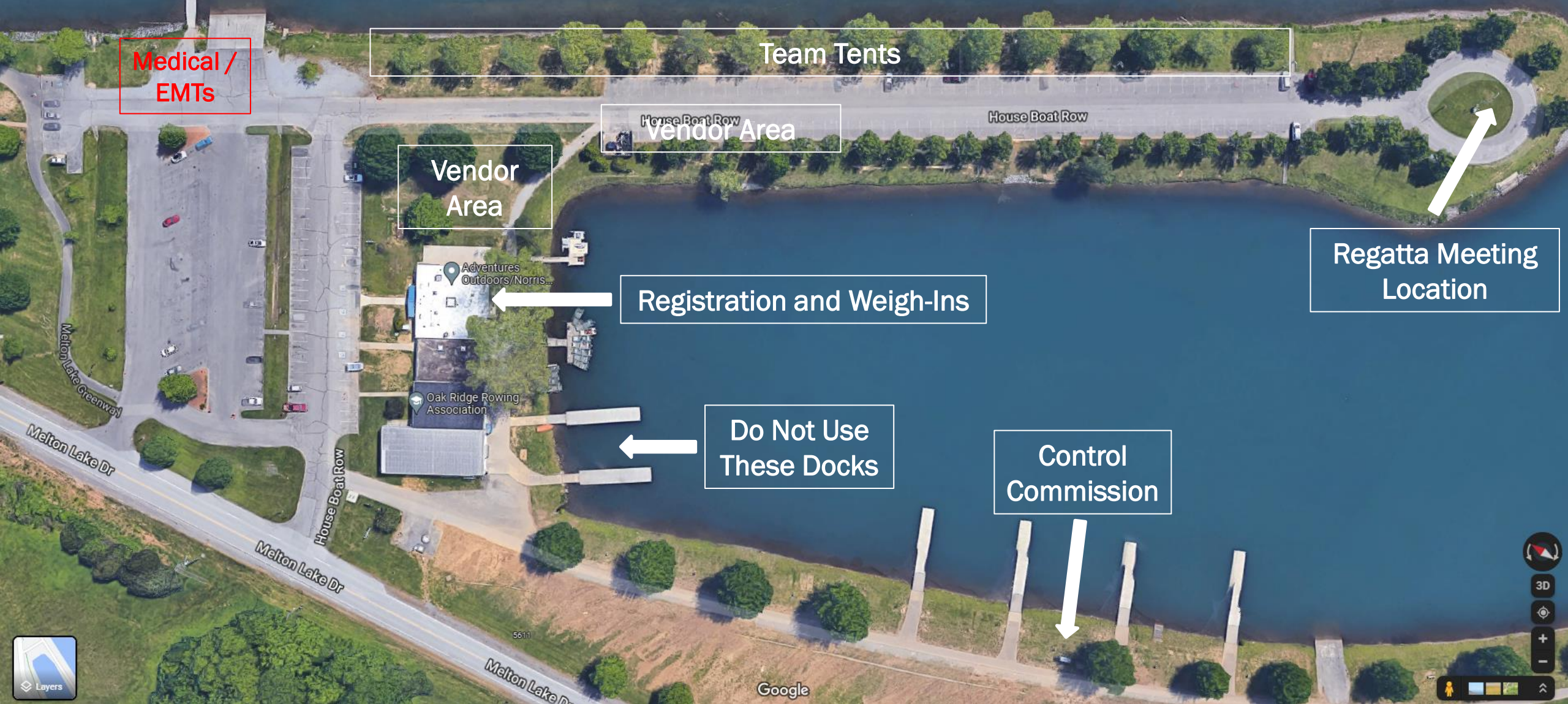

- Trailer Parking opens Wednesday, April 13, 2022 at 12:00 PM.
- Trailers will be directed where to park upon arrival.
- Trailer trucks may not stay in the trailer area. There is parking directly behind your spot on the side of Melton Lake Drive, on a first come, first serve basis.

- Tent stakes are not permitted (please use weights, bags of sand, etc.)

Weather Advisories

Please refer to the entry packet for the weather advisory plan.

The regatta has a Fairness Commission to assess conditions and determine whether lane shifts, postponements, cancellations, or any other alterations to the schedule or race procedures to ensure safety and fairness is warranted. The commission is likely to consist of the Chief Referee, a member of the SIRA Board of Directors involved with regatta management and a third member who is neither a member of the SIRA Board of Directors nor a Referee.

Safety on the Venue

Should inclement weather necessitate a situation where crews must be cleared from the water quickly, the course will be evacuated as follows:

- All crews that are on the start, or above the 1,000 meter mark, will be sent to Restaurant Point
- All crews that are below the 1,000 meter mark will be sent back to the staging area
- The boathouse will have slings set up in the boat bays to accommodate as many boats as possible and athletes that are sheltered in the building
- All four docks will be used to accept returning crews and additional volunteers will be provided to help gather oars off the docks for a speedy return
